VICTORY RANCH Dress Standards

<u>General</u>

- All campers and staff are to present themselves in a manner that reflects positively on their person, the camp, and their Creator. Appearance should be neat, modest, and God-honoring. Any clothing, jewelry, accessories, or hairstyle that distracts from a spiritual atmosphere, draws undue attention to one's self, or could pose a risk to camper safety is prohibited.
- All campers are expected to dress and act like the biological gender that God created them.
- Casual play or athletic clothing is appropriate throughout the day. Nicer clothes should be worn for evening chapel (no shorts).
- Pants should not reveal undergarments when standing, sitting, walking, bending, or reaching. Shorts should come to the mid-thigh (3" or longer inseam).
- Dresses and skirts should be no more than 4" above the knee.
- Leggings or yoga pants, if worn, must be underneath either a tunic-length top or a dress/skirt.
- Garments with shoulder straps of less than 1" width are prohibited.
- Garments such as strapless or halter tops, tube tops, tank tops with deep armholes, shirts or dresses with low necklines, bare midriffs, backless shirts, sheer clothes, tight-fitting clothes, ripped or tattered clothes, and exposed undergarments are not appropriate for camp.
- Pajamas and other sleepwear should not be worn outside the cabin.
- All clothing, jewelry, and personal items (backpacks, water bottles, etc.) must be free of any writing, pictures, or other insignia which are crude, vulgar, profane, sexually suggestive, or gangrelated; contain drug, alcohol, or tobacco advertising, promotions, or likeness; promote or glorify death, mutilation, or violence; or advocate gender, racial, or ethnic prejudice.

Swimwear

- Boys are to wear swim trunks and not speedo-style swimsuits.
- Girls are to wear either a one-piece swimsuit or a two-piece swimsuit that completely covers the midriff (no bikinis). No low neckline, high thigh, or backless designs should be worn.
- If a camper brings a swimsuit that does not follow the above guidelines, she will be expected to wear a dark-colored, full-length t-shirt over it.

Footwear

- Shoes/sandals must be worn at all times, including to and from the swimming pool.
- Closed-toe shoes are required for horse rides.

Piercings

- No body piercings are permitted, except in the ear.
- Plug-style earrings and other piercings not in the ear (nose, lip, etc.) must be covered with a flesh-colored bandage.

Campers in violation of these dress standards will be asked to change or wear attire provided from the camp's "Lost and Found." Repeat violations will be deemed as defiance of the camp rules, and the camper will be sent home at the parent/legal guardian's expense.
