

YOU'RE GOING SUMMER 2025 TO CAMP!



Circle the date on the calendar, tell all your friends, and start packing! We are excited to have your camper joining us at Victory Ranch this summer. We are looking forward to a great week of fun and games, all while learning more about our Lord Jesus Christ. Here are a few tips to help you prepare.

CHECK-IN

Check-in begins at 9:00 a.m. on Monday.

Upon arrival, follow the signs and directions for check-in.

CHECK-OUT

Check-out is at 1:00 p.m. on Thursday.

Check-out takes place in the Dining Hall. Pick up any medication from the First Aid Director and remaining money from the Banker, check Lost & Found for any missing items, and **sign out your camper** before departure.

CAMP BANK

To prevent their spending money from being lost or misplaced, campers will deposit it into the Camp Bank during check-in. The Camp Banker will be available at designated times each day for campers to withdraw money and purchase snacks or General Store items. Offering slips are available during evening chapel (the selected amount will be deducted from the camper's bank funds).

Remember to pick up any remaining money from the Banker during check-out.

WHAT TO BRING

- ◆ Sunscreen
- ◆ Water Bottle
- ◆ Medications (in original container)
- ◆ Spending Money

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- ◆ Cell Phones
- ◆ Electronic Media Devices (video games, tablets, MP3 players, radios, etc.)
- ◆ Magazines
- ◆ Fireworks
- ◆ Alcohol
- ◆ Drugs
- ◆ Tobacco
- ◆ Vapes
- ◆ Weapons (including pocket knives)
- ◆ Anything else that will detract from the camp experience

MEDICATION

All medication will be given to the First Aid Director for dispensing and supervision. **Medication must be brought in the original container, clearly marked with the camper's name!**

Every camper must have a completed Health Form. The First Aid Director will address any instructions or concerns during check-in.

DRESS STANDARDS

All camp attire should be neat, modest, and God-honoring. **The complete VR Dress Standards may be found at www.vranch.org.**

MAIL TIME

Campers love receiving mail! Please send letters and packages addressed to your camper c/o Victory Ranch at 18080 Gilman Springs Road, Moreno Valley, CA 92555. Be sure to send mail early so your camper receives it before the end of camp. Please do NOT send emails.

PHONE CALLS

Due to the volume of normal camp business, we ask that you not call your camper except in case of emergency. Every camper is assigned to a counselor who will know them on a first name basis by the first night. If any problem arises that is hurting the health or well-being of your camper, you will be notified. Visitation during camp is NOT encouraged.

BRING-A-FRIEND SHIRT

Do you know someone who has never, EVER been to Victory Ranch? Invite a friend to camp, and you might qualify for a special "Bring-a-Friend" t-shirt. See www.vranch.org for details.

LOST AND FOUND

Parents, please mark ALL belongings, including clothing, with your camper's name. Before leaving camp, please look through Lost & Found for any misplaced items. Victory Ranch is not responsible for lost or damaged articles belonging to campers.

Lost items must be claimed within two weeks of departure. All unclaimed items will be donated to a needy ministry. Campers must pay the cost of postage to have any left behind items mailed home. Items may also be arranged to be picked up at the camp office.

EARLY DEPARTURE

If your camper needs to be picked up during the week, please bring written permission, signed by the camper's legal guardian(s), to check-in. The permission should state the date, time, and name of the driver authorized to pick up the camper and what time they are expected to return (if applicable). The driver and camper will need to check out and back in at the camp office.

CANCELLATION

The \$50 deposit for summer camp is non-refundable; however, it may be transferred to another 2025 camper who has not yet registered.

Victory Ranch reserves the right to send home at his/her own expense, and without refund, any camper who is rebellious or disobedient.
